## **SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION** **&** **REQUIREMENTS**

The GFWC South Lake Junior Woman's Club (SLJWC) promotes and encourages continued education in the community by awarding at minimum, one (1) student applicant each year, up to \$1000, based on funds raised throughout the year.

- ❖ Student must be a graduate of a South Lake County High School
- ❖ Student must have at least a 2.5 GPA (if wish to attend a Tech School) or a 3.0 GPA (if wish to attend a College or University)
- ❖ This scholarship requires the applicant to volunteer with SLJWC, prior to the application deadline, for at least one (1) shift at a SLJWC event such as SLJWCs Annual Golf Tournament or attend and assist at a Sommer Sports event with SLJWC or with set up or break down of at least two (2) SLJWC monthly meetings.

- ❖ Recipients must be accepted as a full-time student at an accredited community or state college, university or technical school, in Florida.
- ❖ Scholarship funds will be released directly to a school's financial aid office after the SLJWC receives a letter of acceptance and class registration from the student. Funds are mailed out by the month of October of each school year. If the scholarship recipient decides to attend another school, he/she must immediately notify the SLJWC Scholarship Chairperson so the funds may be transferred. Unused student funds from the account must be returned to SLJWC if the following occurs: The recipient stops attending classes and/or withdraws from school for whatever reason and does not immediately transfer to another accredited school. All funds returned to GFWC South Lake Junior Woman's Club will be added to the funds for the following year's awards.

## **DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING**

1. Carefully review the forms provided and the directions below and ensure you follow all instructions.
2. This scholarship packet must be completed by the student and the application signed by the parent.
3. Provide two (2) Letters of Recommendation from a teacher, coach, pastor, mentor, or employer.
4. Provide a copy of your Resume
5. Provide a 1-page, single space essay, stating your need and reason for submitting this application, including your description of “COMMUNITY”, what it means to you, and the positive impacts you have made in South Lake County. Detail your plans for the future and how this scholarship will assist you in achieving those goals.
